Vocabulary for Describing Graph Trends

Word	Part of Speech	Example Sentence
increase	<i>verb</i> : to increase, is increasing, has increased, increased	Total expenditure increased from \$33,611m to \$39,165m from 1995 to 1996.
<i>noun</i> : an increase of \$5,554m an increase in spending of \$5,554m	From 1995 to 1996 there was an increase in expenditure of \$5,554m.	
decrease	<i>verb</i> : to decrease, is decreasing, has decreased, decreased	Expenditure on primary education decreased from 22.2% to 21.5% from 1995 to 1996.



noun: **a decrease of** 0.7%
a decrease in spending of
0.7%
rise

From 1995 to 1996 there was
a decrease in expenditure of
0.7%.
verb: to rise, is rising, has
risen, rose

Total expenditure **rose** from
\$33,611m to \$39,165m from
1995 to 1996.
